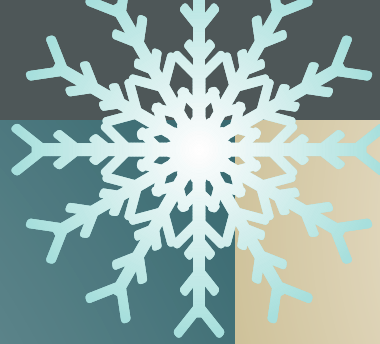

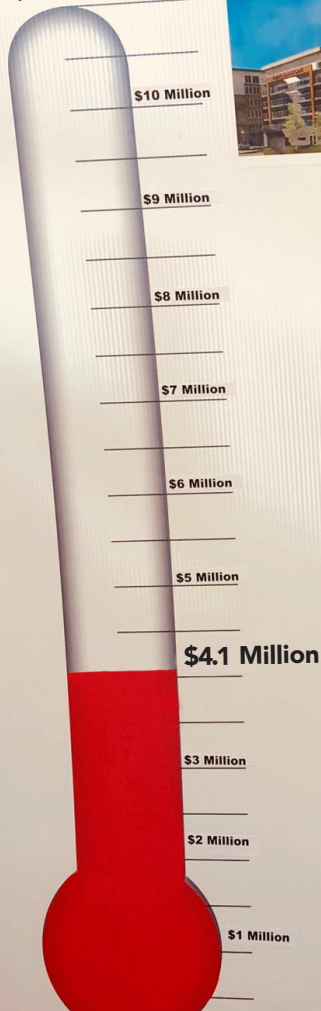

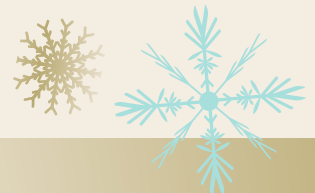

Transforming Tabor Village!

Tabor Village is excited to announce the Launch of the Capital Campaign with over **\$4.1 million** in cash/pledges already raised! Our first priority in transforming Tabor Village is replacing the Tabor Home complex care building that opened in 1960. This outdated facility, which cannot be renovated and is increasingly expensive to operate, no longer provides the spaces that 21st century seniors now expect, require and deserve. It will be replaced with a new, innovative complex care residence that will incorporate new approaches to complex care that address the increasing needs and expectations of seniors, while ensuring that continuity of the nearly 60-year tradition of 'Care from the Heart'.

Transforming Tabor Village—Campaign Launch Event

Joined by over 335 guests for dinner at Garden Park Tower, Tabor Board Chair Vic Martens and Executive Director, Dan Levitt, as well as Abbotsford Mayor Henry Braun marked the start of a major campaign to raise **\$11 million** towards the construction of a new Tabor Village 'Centre For Living' Complex Care facility.

The evening event also featured the incredible voices of the MEI Student Choir, led by Choir Master Dean Wedel, and performances by concert violinist Calvin Dyck accompanied by

the musical talent of Columbia Bible College student, Steven Driediger. A rousing speech of support and gratitude for Tabor Village from Mayor Braun focused on the progressive and innovative mindset for seniors living that has been a hallmark of Tabor Village for almost 60 years at their Clearbrook location.

Construction of a new complex care community will bring with it a new model of care for seniors living with dementia-related conditions is the first major component of the Transforming Tabor Village Campaign.

The new building will replace the outdated care facility on the Tabor 'Campus of Care' and also provide for an increased number of care spaces for seniors.

Tabor Village, a charitable society governed by a volunteer board from 11 participating Mennonite Brethren Churches and others in the Fraser Valley, is a vibrant community known as a place where seniors experience loving Care from the Heart with Christian compassion and respect.
